## I-526E, Immigrant Petition by Regional Center Investor

**ALERT:** Beginning Sept. 1, 2022, we will no longer accept a single, combined fee payment when an applicant or petitioner files [Form I-526, Immigrant Petition by Standalone Investor](#), or [Form I-526E, Immigrant Petition by Regional Center Investor](#), **together** with [Form I-485, Application to Register Permanent Residence or Adjust Status](#), [Form 131, Application for Travel Documents, Parole Documents, and Arrival/Departure Records](#), or [Form I-765, Application for Employment Authorization](#). Petitioners must send a separate fee payment for each form.

If a petitioner or applicant submits a single, combined fee payment for Forms I-526 or I-526E and the other forms, we will reject the forms for improper fee payment and return the fee.

**ALERT:** We will reject all Form I-526 petitions when it indicates that the petitioner's investment is associated with a regional center. Petitions for classification under INA 203(b)(5)(E) should be submitted on Form I-526E.

If you are an investor pooling your investment with one or more qualified immigrants participating in the Regional Center Program, use this form to petition U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) for status as an immigrant to the United States under section 203(b)(5)(E) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (INA), as amended. A regional center investor may also use Form I-526E to report any amendments necessary to establish ongoing eligibility if the regional center, new commercial enterprise, or job-creating entity in which the investor has invested is terminated or debarred from participation in the Regional Center Program.
