1. Agency and Contracting Activity.

The Department of Homeland Security, Customs and Border Protection, Aviation Maritime and Border Technologies Contracting Division, intends to award a sole source Purchase Order.

2. Nature and/or description of the action being approved.

Department of Homeland Security, Customs and Border Protection intends to award a sole source contract to Cellebrite- [REDACTED], Inc., 8065 Leesburg Pike, Suite T3-302 8000 [REDACTED] -Vienna, VA 22182 without seeking competition for Cellebrite Inseyets Ultimate and Unlimited software licenses and equipment. This action is being [REDACTED] [REDACTED] -Cellebrite Inc is the only manufacturer of the Cellebrite Inseyets software. This software application provides unique capabilities of a law enforcement sensitive nature that no other vendor presently provides.

3. Description of Supplies/Services.

The requirement is to procure Cellebrite Inseyets Ultimate and Unlimited software licenses for [REDACTED]

The estimated cost for a Base Year and 3 twelve-month option years is \$2,064,830.32.

This action is being taken in accordance with 41 U.S.C. 1901 as implemented by FAR subpart 13.5 Simplified Procedures for Certain Commercial Products and Commercial Services.

5. Demonstration that the proposed contractor's unique qualifications or the nature of the acquisition requires use of the authority cited.

Cellebrite Inc is the only manufacturer of Cellebrite's Inseyets Ultimate and Unlimited licenses and equipment. Cellebrite Inseyets consolidates all of the Unlocking, Extraction, Automation, Decoding, Parsing, Examination, Reporting, and Management capabilities into a single software license. It is the only vendor in the market that possesses the entire end-to-end capability set covering decades of device support and R&D expertise.

Cellebrite's Inseyets Software Suite contains proprietary methods for accessing encrypted, locked, or damaged devices and holds exclusive agreements with numerous mobile devices manufacturers and application developers, [REDACTED]

6. Description of efforts made to ensure that offers are solicited from as many potential sources as is practicable.

A notice of intent to sole source was placed on www.sam.gov on September 19, 2025. [REDACTED] vendors responded, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Cellebrite maintains a strict process to control who can acquire its digital forensics tools, and it specifically prohibits unauthorized resales. Other companies such as [REDACTED] have similar products, but do not offer the same advanced data extraction capabilities that Cellebrite offers.

9. Any other facts supporting the justification.

Any additional vendors submitting a proposal would be submitting the exact same product, Cellebrite, but as a reseller of Cellebrite. [REDACTED]
