Secretary of Homeland Security Announces Termination of Designation of Burma for Temporary Protected Status, EADs Expire on January 26, 2026

After reviewing country conditions and consulting with the appropriate U.S. government agencies, Secretary of Homeland Security Kristi Noem has [determined](#) that conditions in Burma no longer support its designation for Temporary Protected Status (TPS) and that it is contrary to the national interest to permit Burmese nationals (or aliens having no nationality who last habitually resided in Burma) to remain temporarily in the United States, so she terminated the designation. Burma's TPS designation and related benefits terminate on Jan. 26, 2026, at 11:59 p.m.

Completing Form I-9

Form I-766, Employment Authorization Documents (EADs) with a category A12 or C19 and a Card Expires date of Nov. 25, 2025; May 25, 2024; or Nov. 25, 2022, issued under a prior TPS designation of Burma expire Jan. 26, 2026. Employers must reverify TPS Burma beneficiaries who presented these EADs before they start work on Jan. 27, 2026.
