**SUBJECT:** Sunday Services

This bulletin serves as notice that March 31, 2019, will be the last day of Sunday services at the Mariposa Commercial Facility. This bulletin only applies to commercial truck processing at the facility of Nogales.

Customs and Border Protection (CBP) is facing an unprecedented humanitarian and security crisis all along our Southwest border. In the month of March, CBP is on pace to reach 100,000 apprehensions, which will represent the highest monthly total in a decade. In response to this surge, 750 Customs and Border Protection officers will be deployed to areas being severely impacted.

To lessen the impact of this deployment on legitimate trade and travel, ports are adjusting their workforce and limiting or discontinuing some services. As events unfold, CBP will continue to work out to our partners and port users to keep the community abreast of any changes to operations at the ports. CBP will continue to monitor the situation and strive to restore services as operationally possible.
